

Parent Volunteer Application Franklin DC 2020

The DC PAC (Parent Action Committee) has a commitment to making the Franklin DC trip sustainable. This vision is dependent on you; the parent volunteers. ☺ We are looking for volunteers to make a 2-3-year commitment. On their first trip, volunteers would primarily be trained in the food process. In the following trips, they would be training the next volunteer. If you think this could be you, here are some other things to consider:

- Up to 50% of the time you will have the choice to be with the main group.
- You would be contributing to a program that has substantial value.
- Minimum 2-year commitment)
- Volunteer must be able to pay their way. (Estimate for each year=\$1,625)
- Volunteer must have strong organizational skills, foresight, and flexibility.
- Volunteer must abide by student confidentiality rules.
- Volunteer would be flying out the day before the main group with food prep team.
- A typical day would look like this:
 - Get up an hour before everyone else and begin prepping lunch bar.
 - Students pack their lunches and leave, then you clean up.
 - Meet up with main group for site seeing...a ton of walking..
 - Leave main group early, go back to hotel and prep dinner bar.
 - Students come back to hotel and collect dinner materials to prep in their own hotel rooms
 - Begin prepping for the next day's lunch, sometimes staying up much later than everyone else.
 - Go to sleep. Rinse and repeat.
- This job is very demanding physically, emotionally, and mentally. You will need sufficient stamina to enjoy all the opportunities these nine days offer.
